

The Blessed Sacrament – Our Treasure

Luke 9:11-17

"Sing, my tongue, the Saviour's glory, of His flesh the mystery sing; of the Blood, all price exceeding, shed by our Immortal King, destined, for the world's redemption, from a noble womb to spring."

St Thomas Aquinas wrote a hymn for today's feast day 'Corpus Christi.'

It was to become one of the great seven hymns of the Catholic Church. The hymn is better known in its Latin form namely the '**Pange Lingua**.' The powerful words of the opening verse of that hymn are quoted above in English. St Thomas used his poetic gift to honour God's gift to us all. His hymn is still treasured in our sacred liturgies.

Do you have a treasured possession? What is it? Is it an expensive car or an antique piece of furniture? For many people, money cannot buy their most treasured possession. Precious items tend to be simple things given by some one special. If they are separated from that person by death, distance or circumstance, the object takes on a deeper significance. The pressed flower is not a dead thing but a living expression of love. The faded black and white picture is an invaluable reminder of a soul-mate. Jesus gives us more than a reminder. In our society today, we hear that God helps those who help them selves. In the Blessed Sacrament, Jesus is there to help those who cannot help themselves. Jesus made a promise to the disciples that he would be with us until the end of time.

In the Blessed Sacrament, we see one expression of that promise.

Feasts of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary are on the 3rd/4th June, respectively.

Most Sacred Heart of Jesus we place all our trust in You.
