Parish Finance:

Our Financial Statement for Naas Parish for year ending 31st December 2012 will be on display at Church of the Irish Martyrs, Ballycane and Assembly Area, CBS Secondary School.

Our overall financial position is healthy. However, we have seen our expenditure increase while our income has decreased. Our day to day working account (second collection known as Offertory Collection shows a deficit of &21,470. We need to return this account to break even. In order to achieve that we need to increase our weekly contribution to the second collection by at least &6500.

As we close the Church of Our Lady and St David this week-end and begin the restoration project on Monday we will need to borrow approximately €300,000. With a small additional contribution to the weekly building fund (first collection....blue bag) we believe that this loan can be repaid over a reasonable period of time. It is not our intention to burden the Parish with a long term commitment. If we can manage to do this then we avoid the necessity of any major fundraiser.

In the interest of proper on going maintenance of the parish buildings we will be setting aside 10% of future building fund income for a Building Maintenance Fund. Progress reports will feature in this newsletter and on our website.

We thank you for your co-operation and good will around the changes necessary during the coming months and as always we are truly grateful for your continued help, support and generosity. Fr John
