In the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit:

Today we celebrate the Trinity which is one of the greatest mysteries of our faith. We believe in one God, who is made up of three divine persons. The Trinity is a natural part of our daily faith lives.

We commonly see people bless themselves as they pass a church or cemetery... they do so "in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit..." We start our prayer and the celebration of the Eucharist with this signing of the Trinity also. The Trinity is about relationship, a community of love between Father, Son and Spirit. We are invited into the life of the Trinity, to share in this relationship. This is made very clear in the well known image of the Trinity by Rublev. In it we see the three divine persons united in a relationship of love. There is an empty place at the front of the table where we are invited into this profound love.
