Sharing the Lord's Mission.....

On Monday last there was an open meeting for the people from the parishes of Naas, Sallins, Two Mile House and Kill. It was one of thirteen meetings being held across our diocese to look at the reality of our changing situation as Church. It was an opportunity for an exchange of views and explore possibilities for the future. As we are awaiting the appointment of a new bishop, the meeting was not about making decisions.

Some statistics were put forward at the meeting. One was in relation to the number of priests in our diocese and the trend that is happening at this time. There are 84 priests in our diocese in active ministry. The breakdown age wise is as follows:

- 25 are aged 70+ (75 is the retirement age of a priest)
- 13 are aged 65-69
- 31 are aged 45-64
- 15 are aged under 45

There are 20 retired priests, many who continue to help in parishes. In our own case we are very lucky to have Fr. Moling Lennon and Fr. Colum Swan, who give so generously of their time in retirement, something for which we are deeply grateful. We also have priests from abroad in our diocese, including Fr. Bogdan from Poland. Our diocese has 6 men in formation for the priesthood at this time. 7 men have been accepted for the permanent diaconate and are starting formation. The permanent diaconate is a new venture in Ireland and the full details around this ministry have yet to worked through.

In looking at the overall picture, within *five years*, 25 priests will have retired and the trend continues along a similar vein. This will bring inevitable changes in the near future. What we have been taking for granted within our parishes will be quite different in the coming years. However this poses some exciting challenges too! Over the years greater involvement of lay people has been happening and this will need to be further developed. Pope Benedict in May of last year addressed a Pastoral Conference saying;

"...it is necessary to improve pastoral structures in such a way that the co-responsibility of all the members of the People of God in their entirety is gradually promoted. This demands a change in mindset, particularly concerning lay people. They must no longer be viewed as "collaborators" of the clergy but truly recognised as "co-responsible" for the Church's being and action..."

May we continue to pray that the Lord would guide us along the path ahead.
