Our Posture at Mass:

Last week people may have noticed some changes in the text of the Mass, this was due to the introduction of the Revised Edition of the Roman Missal. When the Mass was translated from Latin to English about forty years ago, following Vatican II, the translation captured the general sense of the prayers rather than the literal translation from Latin to English. In more recent years the Vatican has looked at this and decided that the translation should be a literal translation from the Latin to English, thus resulting in the publication of the Revised Version we are now using.

As these changes have now taken place it was also seen as an opportunity to look at the postures at Mass. It is noticeable in different parishes (and churches even within our own group of parishes) people sit/stand/kneel at different times during Mass. Monsignor Brendan Byrne, the Diocesan Administrator, has asked that we try to standardise the postures we use at Mass. Generally speaking in our parishes of Naas, Sallins and Two Mile House we do use similar postures, however there are some differences. From this weekend the celebrants will try to guide people on the postures at Mass. As with all change this might seem a bit awkward initially, but we hope it will help with the prayerful celebration of Mass in our parishes.
