Today we celebrate the great beginning of the Church. John celebrates the Holy Spirit as part of the first day of the new age of the Risen Christ. The mission of Jesus becomes the mission of the Church. 'As the Father sent me so am I sending you'. The breath of God bestows divine power on the Church to forgive sin that is repented and to pronounce God's judgment on the unrepented sin. The Risen Lord brings peace.....but to receive it one must turn away from sin.

Sunday Funerals.

At a recent meeting with Officials from the Environment Section of Kildare County Council we were informed of a '*New Directive*', which stipulates that it is no longer possible for burials to take place in St. Corbans Cemetery on Sundays'.

Therefore, there will no longer be any Funeral Masses on Sundays'.

As a Parish we are obliged to comply with the *New Directive*.

This new practice will also apply to both Sallins and Two Mile House and takes place with immediate effect.
