

Instead of tight security and police presence, the only thing you'll find is smiles and joy, singing and dancing as young people, culture upon culture and nation upon nation, proudly hold their flags high (or wearing them) greet one another in peace, trading their tokens, humbly realising how small they are in a world of people and strengthened to see so many who share their faith, their conviction.

How did it all begin?

The Late Holy Father, Saint Pope John Paul 11, noted for his love of young people, invited the Youth of the world to join him in Buenos Aires, the year 1986.
