National Eucharist Congress; 25th and 26th June 2011

As part of the preparation for an **International Eucharistic Congress** (Takes place in Ireland, June, 2012) it is traditional that the host countries hold a *National Eucharistic Congress*. Our National Eucharistic Congress will take place on the weekend of the Feast of Corpus Christi, 25th and 26th June 2011.

An invitation is extended to people of every parish in the country to travel to Knock on Saturday 25th June for the National Congress. The normal Public Ceremonies, that we are familiar with at Knock, will be celebrated. The Congress theme of **Communion with Christ and with one another** will provide the context for the celebrations. People who travel to Knock will also have an opportunity to participate in a number of workshops. People are advised to pre-book their place at the workshops on the Congress website, www.iec2012.ie.

At Knock, a Candle will be blessed and sent out to each Diocese. The National Congress will be marked with a liturgy in each Cathedral on Sunday 26th. The Liturgy at the Cathedral of the Assumption Carlow will be in the afternoon at 4pm. All are welcome to attend.

National Collection:

The third National Collection for the 50th International Eucharistic Congress will take place **next weekend**. Last year the *Kildare & Leighlin* collection amounted to €23,762.50. We thank you for your generous support to date.

Congress Bell:

As part of the national preparation for the Congress each diocese is getting the opportunity to host the Congress Bell. Our diocese will host the bell from Thursday, September 29th to Sunday, October 9th, 2011. More details to follow.


