

Luke 7:11-17

Since its creation in 1499, Michelangelo's Pietà has inspired emotion, faith, and imitation. At first it fascinates us when we romantically picture a youthful Michelangelo at work bringing on a cold slab of Italian 'Cararra' marble. If we ponder it long enough and allow ourselves to move beyond the history, we can only but be drawn into the deeper meaning of its purpose: to blend serene beauty with profound sorrow.

That of course is the most appropriate way we can refer to the Blessed Virgin Mary who is left with the broken dead body of her Son strewn across her lap. Only last weekend I was privileged to have time alone in front of the masterpiece whilst praying the Rosary and it was, perhaps for the first time, a moment of intense emotion.

3 was reminded of the countless parents that have endured and continue to endure the agony of losing a child. No matter what the circumstance, no matter what the age, no matter whether it is before delivery of after, there is to the human mind, something chronologically

wrong with this kind of tragedy.

If was reminded of those parents who find out early into a pregnancy that their child's life span will be minutes rather than years or will be one of silence and inactivity instead of noise and animation. I was reminded of those parents who heroically each and every day give everything to the 24/7 care and attention required by a child with special needs, those sitting by a hospital bed not knowing the outcome of a present illness or unfortunate accident. I was reminded of those parents who feel helpless as they watch their children go down into the cul-de-sacs of life and, no matter how hard they try, can't seem to rescue them or refocus them.

If, reading this reflection today, you are one of those parents, I thought of you ... I prayed earnestly for you and like the Prophet Elijah I found myself pondering almost the same words "Lord my God, do you mean to bring grief?" It of course is never God's will to bring grief ... only love. For those who have lost a child, for those caring for a child with a life limiting condition, for those caring for a child with serious medical. emotional. educational behavioural difficulties when I gazed on the face of Our Blessed Lady in the Pieta, I saw you there a living replica of the Pieta, quietly living out your lives - lives in which you have learned, like our Blessed Lady, to blend beauty with sorrow.

It is not by chance you do this. It is a result of the promise of God that He will not leave us ... He will not desert us ... He will be there with us every step of the way.
