SYNOD on the FAMILY

This month Pope Francis will hold a Synod (a gathering of Bishops from around the world) to reflect on the Family, in light of the changing understanding of all aspects of family life from conception to parenting, to marriage, to cohabiting, to partnership and same sex relationships, and the many complex issues now arising and being considered in the world.

Pope Francis wants to consider how best the Church can minister to people in situations where families have difficulties, brokenness, separation, divorce and especially where individuals have formed second relationships and wish to participate fully in the life of the Church.

The Synod will not provide answers; a further session will take place next year to offer a Church perspective and some recommendations on family life. Please pray for the guidance of the Holy Spirit on the Synod, and for the Family, which is under such attack at this time in western cultures.

A simple prayer you may wish to use is:

"Jesus, Mary and Joseph, with complete confidence we entrust our family to you. Make our home a place of prayer and peace, a place of love and kindness, like the home of Nazareth. Watch over and protect each of us from every danger. Keep us always close to you and to each other. Amen"

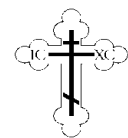

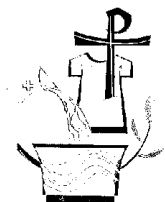
