Last week Archbishop Romero was beatified as a martyr for the faith. He was shot dead while celebrating Mass because he continued to challenge the military government of his country for their corrupt practices and murder of their opponents. This passage is from one of his most prophetic and Christian sermons. On this feast of Corpus Christi let it remind us that we are all part of one Body of Christ in the Church. That body is still being martyred today in various parts of the world. In a spirit of solidarity (the death of one diminishes us all) pray for our sisters and brothers who are being persecuted for professing Christ as Lord.

Archbishop Oscar Romero's Prayer;

It helps, now and then, to step back and take a long view.

The kingdom is not only beyond our efforts, it is even beyond our vision.

We accomplish in our lifetime only a tiny fraction of the magnificent enterprise that is God's work.

Nothing we do is complete, which is a way of saying that the kingdom always lies beyond us.

This is what we are about. We plant the seeds that one day will grow.

We water seeds already planted, knowing that they hold future promise.

We cannot do everything, and there is a sense of liberation in realising that.

This enables us to do something, and to do it very well.

It may be incomplete, but it is a beginning, a step along the way,

an opportunity for the Lord's grace to enter and do the rest.

We are workers, not master builders; ministers, not messiahs

We are prophets of a future not our own. Amen
