Undoubtedly, one of the most important events of this year will be the centenary celebration of the apparitions of Our Blessed Lady to the shepherds Francisco (8) Jacinta (6) and Marto and Lucia Dos Santos (9) at Fatima, Portugal. Next Saturday, 13th May the two youngest of the children will be canonised by Pope Francis when he visits the world famous shrine. This will be the first time in the history of the Church that two non-martyred children will be raised to the glory of the altars.

It should be remembered that a year before the apparitions of Our Lady occurred the Angel of Peace appeared to the children three times. If we were to summarise these angelic apparitions, we should say that the content of the first appearance is an invitation to pray; the second, a call to sacrifice; and the third, a call to offer oneself for the salvation of sinners. It should also be noted that during the Angel's appearances, he dictated two profound 'Eucharistic' prayers to the children which they guickly took to heart

and repeated for the rest of their holy lives. We would do very well to make these prayers our own as they can only help deepen our participation in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass - the source and summit of our Christian life.

On the first of the Angels appearances he invited the children to pray with him and bowing profoundly he said three times "My God, I believe, I adore, I trust, and I love You. I beg pardon of You for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not trust, and do not love You." What a beautiful simple prayer that we could offer to God at the moment of the elevation of the Sacred Host and the Precious Blood. The Angel finished this visitation with a request to the children to "Pray this way!"

On the third visit the Angel appeared with a chalice in his hand over which a Host was suspended, from which fell some drops of Blood. Leaving these suspended in the air, he knelt and repeated three times with the children. "Most Holy Trinity - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, I adore you profoundly. I offer you the most precious Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ, present in all the tabernacles in the world, in reparation for all the outrages, sacrileges and indifferences by which he is offended. Through the infinite merits of His Most Sacred Heart and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I beg of you the conversion of poor sinners." Then he rose, took the Host, and gave it to Lucia, while he gave the precious Blood in the chalice to Jacinta and Francisco. It is obvious from the actions of the Angel, that this prayer is one of great Eucharistic importance, one that is pleasing to God and one that makes a very beautiful and personal post communion prayer. The Angel's message is a prophetic message, one that not only explains the will of God for the present time, but also helps us recognise the presence of Christ in all times.
