with effect from Sunday 5th October 2014***

Following consultation with the Parish Team, Pastoral Council, and Ministry Coordinators, the following Mass times will operate, in Naas, from Sunday, October 5th, 2014:

**Our Lady and St David's: 9am, 11am and 6pm
(9am Mass replaces both the 8.30 and 10 Masses).**

**Church of the Irish Martyrs:
10.30am and 12noon.**

All other Mass times, in the three parishes, remain unchanged.

Ministers will be notified of roster adjustments and the main choirs will sing at the 10.30am and 11 am Masses.

We ask for your understanding and acceptance of these changes, necessitated by the reduction of priests available to serve at this time and our desire to offer prayerful and inclusive worship options to our faithful people.

Thank you for your fidelity to Holy Mass and your parish family. As the old Irish saying puts it so well: "*Is ar scath a cheile a mhaireann na ndaoine*" (it's in the shadow of each other the people have life!).

Let us continue to pray for each other at this time of change and challenge.

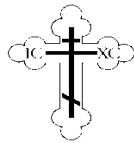
