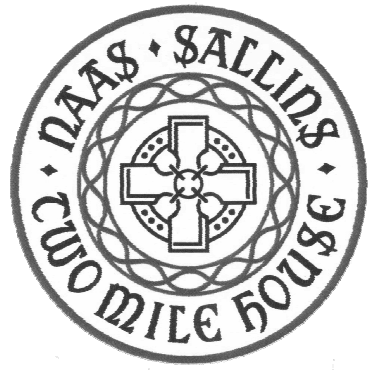

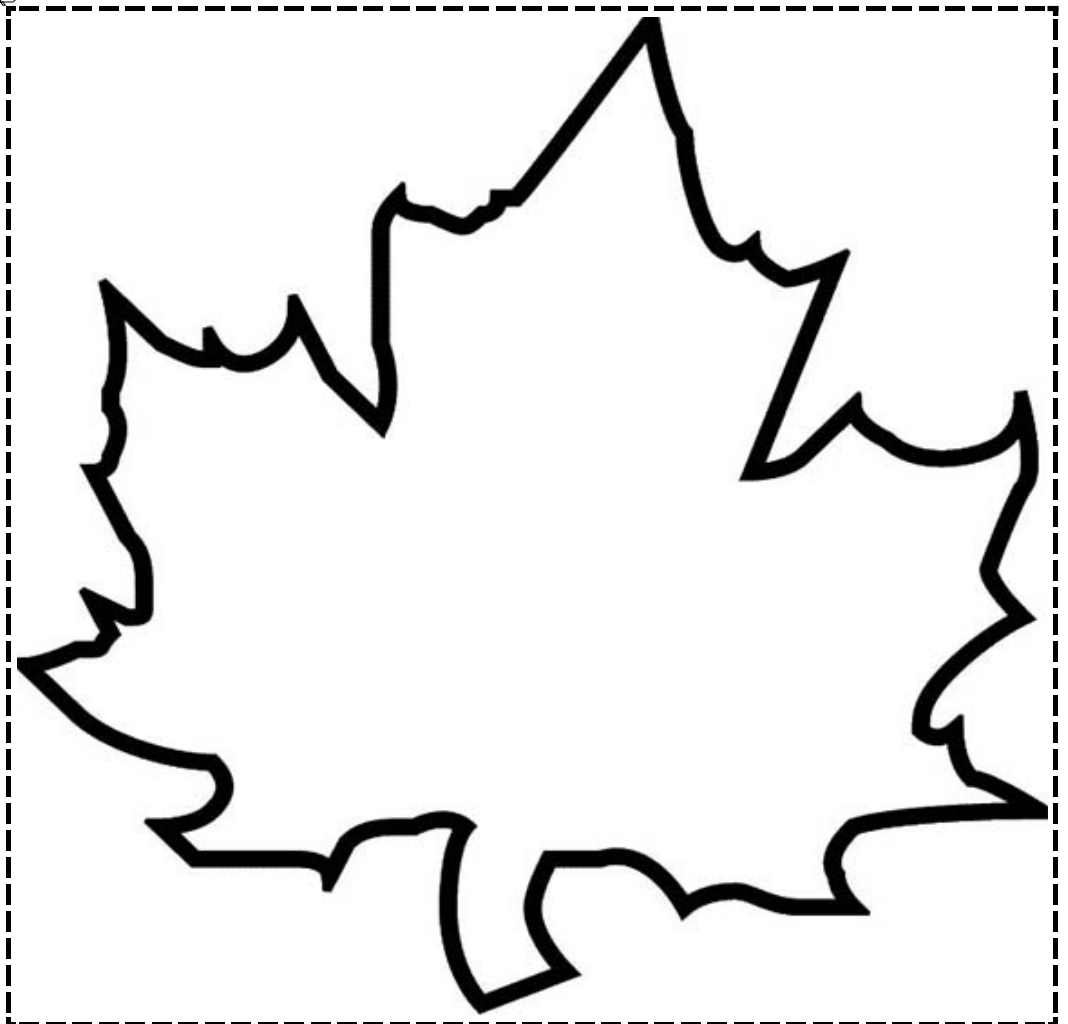
Mark: 12: 28-34

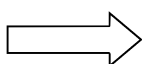
