Wrapped in the Love of God



Advent is 'Wake up' time! Be alert; be attentive to the choices you make. A new season of life begins at Advent and there are steps we must take in the right direction. Newness is in the air. Choose now!

This second Sunday of Advent, a beautiful invitation to 'wrap the cloak of beauty around you'. It is a message of comfort and consolation that in the midst of sorrow and

distress, we are wrapped lovingly and safely in the gentle embrace of God. The notion of being wrapped echoes the Baptismal Rite when the Baptismal shawl is wrapped around the newly Baptised child.

Reminder too, that we are often wrapped in the love of family, of people near and dear to us and most especially in the love of Jesus, Mary and Joseph. That collective love and encouragement is a source of inspiration and hope.

In the midst of sorrow, distress, moments when life is tough, we hear the clarion call of the Gospel to make time and space for the Lord. Advent time... a time to soothe, to bring hope, to bring light to troubled souls. And perhaps these words of Anne Frank from her diaries, she who knew the darkness of pain and suffering might resonate somewhere deep within.

'Today the sun is shining the sky a deep blue and there is a lovely breeze and I am longing – so longing for everything. For talk, for freedom, for friends, just to be alone. And I do so long to cry. I feel as if I am going to burst because there is so much to cope with and so much fear and so much angst. My heart wants to fold up and sleep and it cries out to God saying, 'Can't you satisfy my longing'? All God says in reply is to stay awake and be alert and the sun will burst the clouds. I trust.'

Baby Jesus from your Crib:

For the past several decades, each year on Gaudete Sunday, children and adults bring their Baby Jesus figure from the crib in their homes to St. Peter's Square in Rome where the Holy Father blesses both the people and the figurines during the Angelus. This has become affectionately known as 'Bambinelli Sunday'.

This year we will celebrate 'Bambinelli Sunday' in our three Parishes. Families are invited to bring the figure of the Baby Jesus to any of the Communion Masses (please see list of Communion Mass times enclosed). A suggestion is, following the blessing, take your 'Bambinelli' home and place it in a gift box, wrap it and save it for Christmas. Let this be the first gift your family open on Christmas morning and together place the Baby Jesus into the family crib. Say a prayer of blessing together asking God to protect your family and thanking God for the gift of His Son.
