## 'Volunteering Sunday' - Would you like to help?

Voluntary workers are "among the most precious things the Church has" who express the "most noble desires of the human heart". Pope Francis said this to an audience in St Peter's Square to mark the Jubilee of Volunteer Workers in 2016.

He added, "Your presence is the hand of Christ held out to all, and reaching all,". During his catechesis, the Pope stressed how the Church

is called to be close to those in need and encouraged volunteers in their solidarity towards others, especially in a world tempted by indifference.

Pope Francis concluded by citing the example of mercy shown by Saint Teresa of Calcutta. He continued by saying that volunteering "is the most beautiful service we can give as missionary disciples. To prepare the way so that all people may know, meet and love the Lord".

The Parish of Naas is totally blessed by the participation and active involvement of so many volunteers across so many areas of Parish life. It is essentially the life blood of the Parish to have people involved as readers, collectors, altar servers and the many other Parish groups.

On the weekend of the 9th/10th March, we are asking and inviting people to become more involved. There is an open door of welcome to any Parishioner who might express an interest in participating in some aspect of Parish life. You can make such a difference and your possible involvement would be welcomed!
