THE PASSION PLAY - OBERAMMERGAU 2020

HOLIDAY/PILGRIMAGE PERFORMED ONCE EVERY TEN YEARS!

We have had a strong interest in the Pilgrimage so far, please see below for some further details which might be of interest to you. Should you wish to book your place, please call in to the Parish Office on the Sallins Road. Departing Dublin Airport on Wednesday, July 15th at 10.35am, we will arrive in Munich at 1.55pm for seven nights. Fr. Liam is our tour leader for this pilgrimage.

The first hotel we will be staying at is *Hotel Tiefenbrunner* (July 15th - July 20th) which is a family-run hotel and can be found in the heart of Kitzbühel.

On Friday, July 17th, we will depart Kitzbühel for a *Walking Tour of Salzburg* where we will discover the captivating beauty of this city through it's rich history and culture. We will be led through the UNESCO city of Salzburg by an experienced guide who will explain the history as we explore.

We will make our way to our second hotel on Monday, July 20th, which is *Hotel Wittelsbach* in the heart of picturesque Oberammergau.

The *Passion Play* will then take place on Tuesday, July 21st. In the middle of the Thirty Years War, after months of suffering and death from the plague, the Oberammergauers swore an oath that they would perform the "*Play of the Suffering, Death and Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ*" every ten years. This tradition has endured, almost without interruption for 380 years. It is regarded as the most important Passion Play in the world.

The total cost for this pilgrimage is €1,890 per person sharing a twin room with €200 deposit per person required. The cost includes return flight tickets, private transfers, walking tour of Salzburg, five night stay in Kitzbühel and two night stay in Oberammergau (both half board, sharing an Austrian twin bed) and also tickets for The Passion Play (Category One Seating).

Given the cost of the Pilgrimage, the Parish are happy to facilitate payments by weekly or monthly instalments. Please check with Sarah or Katie in the Parish Office.




