## May the Month of Mary

May is the month when Catholics traditionally focus on Mary, the Mother of Jesus. The practice dates back at least 700 years and is still observed around the world today. May is seen as the beginning of new life and the start of summer, which makes this a logical

time for the celebrations of Mary who brought life into the world. Pope Francis consecrated his papacy to Mary, under the title of Our Lady of Fatima, and he invited everyone to consecrate themselves to her tender, loving care.

## May Devotions

There are several Marian feast days in May, including Our Lady of Fatima, Our Lady of the Most Blessed Sacrament and Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

The celebration of May as a holy month for Mary has been ratified by several Popes through the ages. Pope Benedict XV ordered a prayer for peace in 1915 during World War I and Pope Pius XII called for May devotions in 1939, at the start of World War II.

## May Altars

The month of May is a time to look forward to better weather and enjoy the flowers and plants which are starting to bloom. This is a good time to create a small altar at home to pay tribute to Mary. Use a small statue if you have one, or a picture of Mary from a prayer card or prayer book. If not, a set of rosary beads or a small crucifix placed on the altar can also help with devotions. Have a chair or stool nearby to encourage family members to stop by and perhaps offer prayers to Mary during the day. Any flowers can be used for a home altar.



If you have children at home they can pick the flowers for Our Lady every day from the garden and as the flowers are placed on the altar a prayer or hymn can be said/ sung. Children might also like to cut out and colour in the picture of Mary on the back page of this newsletter, to place on their altar at home.

### Marian Shrines

Marian Shrines also receive particular attention during this special month and, again, are decorated with flowers. Pilgrims sometimes undertake a journey to reach a particular Shrine, praying the rosary along the



way. This May the rosary will be said in <u>Kill before the Statue of our Lady at 9.30am every morning and in Kilcullen Church at 8pm every evening.</u>
