Vigil of Prayer for Vocations Feast of the Sacred Heart (28 June 2019)

The Feast of the Sacred Heart is a yearly reminder to us of God's love. For many years, the sanctuary of our homes, the family kitchen, often was decorated with an image of the Sacred Heart. While the artistic merit of some of these images was questioned, the simple truth of what they sought to express was that Christ was welcome to our table-He was welcome there where families gathered to be sustained and nurtured, to share food and conversation, to tell their stories in the warmth and intimacy of the family setting.

Lives have changed and, in an ever more hectic world, fewer families will ever sit together for meals but still the image of that sacred companion will often warm the hearts of those who see that old friend smile down on them. The God who is welcomed into our "kitchened" life is not a God of wrath and anguish but a gentle warm presence who seeks to remind us that trust in him does not go astray.

In that spirit of trust in the God who is kind, we invite people to come together in prayer on the Feast of the Sacred Heart as we will keep a **vigil of prayer in the Church of the Irish Martyrs, Ballycane, on Friday night 28th June. We will begin with Mass at 7.30pm, followed by exposition of the Blessed Sacrament with moments of guided prayer and then moments of silent adoration until Midnight,** when we will conclude with the Office of Readings and Benediction. Confession will be available also at specific times during the night.

The focus of our prayer will be prayer for Vocations to the Priesthood and the Consecrated life. Throughout the vigil, we will keep in mind the Lord's words to us that the first step in hearing his call and in answering him is in the silence of night-time prayerfulness, as Christ himself prayed before he called the first disciples. We hope also to pray with the thoughts and memories of the founders of some of the religious congregations who have been active locally and some inspiring characters from our own time who have borne witness to Christ.

What can you do? We suggest the following:

- + People can sign up to be present at a specific time. We will have a rota of designated persons who will take responsibility for being present for each of the four hours of the Vigil and people can contact the Parish Office to volunteer to make an hour of the Vigil.
- + Those who might like to participate in the guided prayer moments, particularly those who might like to read or lead singing in those moments, can also leave their names in the Office.
- + Hospitality will be important and we will need people to help with preparing and offering refreshments at moments during the Vigil.
- + People might also help with the practical preparations that will need to happen beforehand, e.g. preparing and decorating the Altar and the Church.
- + Otherwise, please just come along when you can and join in the prayer and the watching during the night!
