# Parish Baptism Information

The child's birth certificate must accompany an application for Baptism

## Naas:

1. Church of Our Lady and St David:  
Baptisms take place on 2nd and 4th Sunday of each month at 12.30pm.
2. Church of the Irish Martyrs, Ballycane:  
Baptisms take place every Saturday at 12.30pm.

## Two Mile House:

Baptisms take place on the 2nd Sunday of each month at 11.45am.

## Sallins:

Baptisms take place on the 1st Saturday of each month at 12.30pm.

## Baptism Meetings:

Baptismal Meetings take place in Meeting Room Number 4 in Ballycane Church on 2nd and 4th Tuesday of each month at 8pm. Please note the following:

- a) Parents are requested to attend a Baptism Meeting prior to their child's christening.
- b) These meetings are conducted by one of the Parish's Baptismal Team and last for approximately one hour.
- c) At these meetings the sacrament and ceremony of Baptism is discussed and explained.
- d) Godparents are also welcome to attend meetings.

## Important Notes for Parents

Please return this form to the Parish Office located on the Sallins Road **not less than 14 days before the date of baptism**, otherwise the baptism cannot take place.

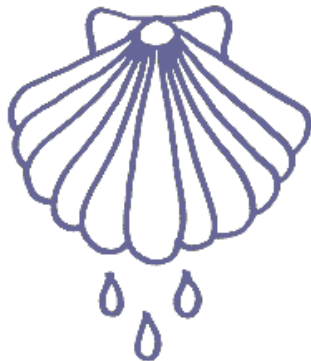
As a parent or godparent you should ask yourself:

1. Are you prepared to the best of your ability to give your child a Christian upbringing within the family of God's Church?
2. Will you help your child to be regular in public worship and in prayer, not only by your teaching but also by your example and your prayers?
3. Will you encourage your child, in due time, to prepare for and come to Holy Communion and Confirmation?

In the case of godparents, it is usual to have two; one female and the other male. If one male and one female godparent cannot be located, then one godparent will suffice.

Godparents should be baptized and confirmed and over the age of 16 years.

Sponsors / witnesses in addition to godparents are permitted.
