

### New Carpet

There has been a very positive reaction to the placing of the new carpet upon the Sanctuary, many Parishioners have commented on how it gives focus and warmth to the Church while highlighting the Sanctuary area. The cost of fitting and placing the carpet came to €11,800 (most competitive quote). Other works recently completed in the Parish include tarmacadam at Ballycane Church; €8,000, enhanced signage for Parish Shop and Office; €3,355. 

### THE VOCATION OF THE SICK (TUESDAY 11TH FEBRUARY 2020)

11th February, Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, is the International Day of Prayer for the Sick. Each year, we remember the moment when Our Lady spoke to a young Basque girl in the grotto in Lourdes and asked her to remind the world that the sick have a place in society and in the Church. It was a powerful and a prophetic moment. So often the sick are forgotten and disregarded, but they have a powerful role in the heart of the Church as they remind us of Christ, who became weak and powerless so as to bring us into a lasting relationship with God.

Each year on this day we celebrate the dignity and the vocation of those who carry the Cross of Christ in any form of sickness, disability or woundedness. While the sick need the strong for help and support, the strong need the sick to remind us that the human journey will always, at some stage, need patience, trust and receptivity. Those who carry the Cross of sickness demonstrate those characteristics for us all. Those who suffer, in body or in mind, are a necessary and valued component of the life of the church and of the world.

This Tuesday, 11th February, we celebrate the sacrament of the sick at 10am Mass in both the Church of Our Lady & St David, Naas and The Church of Our Lady & the Guardian Angels, Sallins. Please try to help anyone who might want to attend, but might not have the means to do so, to be present. It is always a beautiful moment of healing because healing is the gift of the sick to those around

them. Mistakenly, we often assume that the sick are the only ones in need of healing, but often they are the very ones who bring healing and hope into our lives. That is what we celebrate as we remember Bernadette of Lourdes and her great adventure!
