O Mary, Queen of Ireland, when you appeared at Knock,

Yesterday we celebrated the Feast of the Assumption, and we might pray again the above 'Prayer of Consecration of Ireland to the Immaculate Heart of Mary,' introduced by Archbishop Eamon Martin in March of this year (full text is available on catholicbishops.ie). In it, we pray for the protection of Mary in these difficult times, particularly for those who are sick and those who minister to them. As someone who knew deep suffering, we can always turn to our Mother Mary in our pain and distress. Today's Gospel highlights the beginning of Mary's journey. While we often think of Mary as a meek character, passively accepting God's plan for her, the woman we meet today is the epitome of joy, as she exclaims: 'My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord and my spirit exults in God my saviour.' Her prayer, the Magnificat, overflows with joy and delight. In spite of her fears for the future, in spite of the sorrows that await her, she is filled with joy and moved to praise God.
