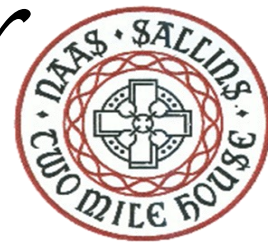

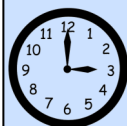

## **NAAS PARISH OFFICE AND SHOP - FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

1. As we are not physically attending Mass in the Church, how do we continue to make our weekly donations?

A box for posting donations is available in the Church of Our Lady and St David, on Saturday and Sunday afternoons, by the DONATE option on the parish website, [www.naasparish.ie/donate](http://www.naasparish.ie/donate), envelopes, whether weekly church envelopes or any other envelope, can be dropped into the letterbox of the Parish Office on the Sallins Road. The Parish Office can also take payments over the phone. *Your continued support of the Parish Finances is deeply appreciated.*

2. Can I still buy a Mass Card/Bouquets?

They can be ordered online on the parish website [www.naasparish.ie/parish-cards](http://www.naasparish.ie/parish-cards). You can also fill in an order form, which is available in Our Lady and St. David's Church, and post it into the letterbox for the Parish Office on the Sallins Road. Call the Parish Office(s) on 045 879 730 (Naas) & 045 895 629 (Ballycane) to place an order and pay by card.

With each of the above, we can write and post the card for you, or, if you prefer, we can send you the cards to you to write yourself. Once you have ordered your card online or over the phone, you can also avail of our 'collect' service and can arrange a time with us to collect your card(s) at the Parish Office.

3. How can I still receive my catholic publications or make purchases from the Parish Office Shop?

4. Can I still have names added onto the Tuesday (living) and Wednesday (deceased) lists for the Altar?

Names can be written down and placed into the letterbox of the Parish Office. You can call the Parish Offices and we will write the names in for you.
