Irish Martyrs Memorial Day - Sunday June 20th

As the Memorial Day for the 17 Irish Martyrs occurs today, we have listed below the names of the Martyrs to bring to mind those to whom the Church of the Irish Martyrs was dedicated on March 9th 1997.

The practice of the Catholic faith in Ireland was for centuries a capital crime that resulted in the martyrdom of many thousands of the faithful. The canonisation of Oliver Plunkett in 1975 brought an awareness of the other men and women who died for the Catholic faith in the 16th and 17th centuries. These 17 Irish Martyrs were a



representative group of a larger number of martyrs and were beatified in Rome by Pope John Paul II in 1992.

17 Irish Martyrs: Patrick O'Healy (Franciscan, Bishop of Mayo) and Conn O'Rourke (Franciscan) - both hanged at Kilmallock, 13th August 1579. Matthew Lambert (baker) and Robert Myler, Edward Cheevers, Patrick Cavanagh (sailors) - all hanged at Wexford, 5th July 1581. Dermot O'Hurley (Archbishop of Cashel) - hanged at Dublin, 20th June 1584. Margaret (née Bermingham) Ball (a widow) - died in prison at Dublin, 1584. Fr. Maurice MacKenraghty hanged at Clonmel, 20th April 1585. Dominic Collins (Jesuit lay brother) - hanged at Youghal, 31st October 1602. Conor O'Devany (Franciscan, Bishop of Down & Connor) and Fr. Patrick O'Loughran - both hanged at Dublin, 1st February 1612. Francis Taylor (a merchant) - died in prison at Dublin, 30th January 1621. Peter Higgins (Dominican, of Naas) - hanged at Dublin, 23rd March 1642. Terence Albert O'Brien (Dominican, Bishop of Emly) - hanged at Limerick, 30th October 1651. John Kearney (Franciscan) - hanged at Clonmel, 11th March 1653. William Tirry (Augustinian) - hanged at Clonmel, 2nd May 1654.
