This celebration reassures our older people that they are loved and that they are needed. It renews the commitment of the Church to the pastoral care of our older



people, a group who have been affected in so many ways by the Covid 19 Pandemic, particularly through being isolated from their family, friends and from the practice of their faith as well as missing many of the social supports which are so important to all of us.

As our country begins to open again, with many of our older people vaccinated and able to venture out again to enjoy the company of those they have missed, we will be delighted to join in this very special day of celebration. In each of our churches on Sunday 25th July, we will mark the World Day for Grandparents and Older People at a Mass, which we invite grandparents and children to join, either in person or via the webcam (please see Mass times below).

We thank God for Grandparents, and the role they play in families. We thank God for our older priests, who in their retirement continue to play such an active role in our parishes. We thank God for those who care for older people within their family home, in hospital, in assisted living facilities, or in our nursing homes. We thank God above all for the love that exists between grandparents and grandchildren, and for the generations that went before all

of us, and helped to shape us into people of faith.
