Congratulations to our 21 Pope John Paul Awardees!

Sincere congratulations to twenty one young people from the Parishes of Naas, Sallins and Two Mile House who recently received their Pope John Paul Awards at Bronze, Silver, Gold and Papal Cross level. These Awards are presented by the Diocese of Kildare and Leighlin to young people in Senior Cycle in Secondary School or in College who serve their Parish, School and Community.

Each young person is committed to playing an active role in Parish life, contributing to their school in a meaningful way, and volunteering in a social awareness project within the community. The projects this year range from shopping for older people cocooning during lockdown to serving as Ministers of the Word at Mass, from coaching children's sports teams to producing videos for the First Communion classes, from Tidy Towns to prayer on Zoom. We are grateful for their involvement in our parish, and look forward to seeing them continue this participation into the future.

Bishop Denis Nulty presented Papal Crosses to Cóilín Campbell, Peter Cowley and Paula Hennessy on October 13th at a socially distanced Awards Ceremony in Carlow Cathedral, and the Parish presented the Bronze, Silver and Gold Awards to the rest of the group at Mass on Saturday evening, 16th October. Thank you to the Youth Ministry Team and particularly to the award leaders who enabled this to happen!

Following the presentation of medals, Bishop Denis addressed all recipients: "Pope Francis speaks very often directly to young people. 'The Church needs you, your enthusiasm, your creativity and the joy that is so characteristic of you.... You can be joyful witnesses of His love, courageous witnesses of His Gospel, carrying to this world a ray of His light.' As JPII Awardees you are all worth more than gold, silver and bronze, even the Papal Cross award – you are worth more because of your engagement, your involvement, your participation in your parish, your school and wider community. I wish you every blessing and once again thank your priests who encourage you, your teachers who inspire you and your Award Leaders who mentor you."

To the Parishioners of Sallins Parish...

Above, we publish the Income and Expenditure Accounts for the year 2020. As I mentioned in last weeks note to all three parishes, 2020 was a year that brought immense upheaval, experienced collectively and personally for so many. However, amid all that challenge, the people of Sallins Parish remained steadfast in their support and generosity. Yes, there was a major drop in income, demonstrated in the dramatic decline in the <u>Offertory Collection</u>; \in 35,322 in 2019, \notin 11,997 in 2020.

The Envelope Collection held steady, proving just how important it is to the parish finances. We thank all who choose this option. It further allows us, when parishioners are willing to participate, to benefit from the Tax Refund Scheme. Your participation allowed the parish to claim an additional \notin 9,602, this gave rise to a surplus of Income over Expenditure to the tune of \notin 6,238, a positive outcome!

At our most recent Finance Committee meeting (Last Tuesday), the Finance Committee decided to paint the exterior of Sallins Church: roof, windows etc. This work will happen in the Spring of 2022.

Once again our renewed thanks for your support to the parish and for the support given to us, the priests of the parish, by the way of the 'Priests Collections'. Your support and generosity is deeply appreciated.

To each of you, our sincere thanks and prayer-filled gratitude.

To the Parishioners of Two Mile House Parish...

Above, we publish the Income and Expenditure Accounts for 2020. Firstly, I want to begin by expressing a heartfelt thank you for your ongoing support to the parish, even in the midst of repeated lockdowns, you found a way to support the parish, for this I am most grateful. It's a similar story to Naas and Sallins, you will note the dramatic decline in the Offertory Collection, a drop of €16,139. The envelope collection actually saw a small increase on the previous year.

Underlying the importance of the envelope collection, in 2019 the parish was able to reclaim \notin 9,133 in the Tax Refund Scheme. It is an enormous help to the parish, and yet so easy as a process. As in all parishes throughout the diocese, Bishop Denis, for a period of time, suspended the Diocesan Levy, our payment for 2020 was just \notin 1,796. In its own way, it contributed to a surplus of Income over Expenditure to the tune of \notin 4,299.

On a point of information the Finance Committee has made the decision to refurbish the Sacristy in Two Mile House, it badly needs a 'makeover'. We have engaged Burkes Joinery to carry out this work.

Again, my renewed thanks for your support to Two Mile House Parish and to us, the Priests of the Parish, it is deeply appreciated.


