St. Therese of Lisieux - A much loved Saint

It is amazing to quietly observe the constant stream of people who make their way down to the back of the Church, in Our Lady and St David, to the statue of St. Therese of Lisieux. As a saint she resonates so deeply with the hearts of so many people. In Therese one finds a closeness to God, of a young sister who lived a somewhat obscure life at the convent in Lisieux.

Few sisters are more popular than this young woman who died in 1897 at the age of 24. Her autobiography, 'The Story of a Soul', is read and loved throughout the world. Life at the convent was indeed uneventful but Therese possessed holy insight that it is the simple things done well, the quiet suffering, the praying for others that can become your most profound gift. Her mission was to pray for others, shortly before she died, she wrote: "I want to spend my heaven doing good on earth".

Therese has much to teach our modern age of the image, the appearance, the 'self'. We have

become desperately self-absorbed, painfully aware of the need to be fulfilled, yet knowing we are not. Therese sought to serve others, to do something outside herself, to forget herself in quiet acts of love.

She is one of the great examples of the gospel paradox, that we gain our life by losing it, and that the seed that falls on the ground must die in order to live (John 12). Preoccupation with self separates us from the needs or awareness of others. Forgetting ourselves, contemplating God, draws us out of ourselves, in order to serve and look after others. The true expression of being Christ like.

A quote from St Therese. The other morning I received a text from a parishioner, it read: "Life is a moment between two eternities... the loveliest masterpiece in the Heart of God is the heart of a mother". This random text message demonstrates an affinity or closeness that people feel toward St Therese! Yes, a much loved saint.




