An Advent Character & an Invitation for us to Walk in Faith: St Joseph

The year of St Joseph draws to a close on December 8th. If you haven't had a chance to ponder his story perhaps now is a good time! As an Advent character, his was a supporting role in the truest sense of the word - and yet his choices mattered so much!

Joseph's story can remind each of us that our willingness to take the journey of faith affects everything. It tells us that walking in faith will require something of us, perhaps more than we thought we were capable of. But it also tells us that if we say yes to God and trust in his path for us, like Joseph, we, too, can find our place in the greatest story ever told. We, too, can experience God-with-us. Bambinelli Sunday, 12th December 2020

For the past several decades, each year on Gaudete Sunday, children and adults bring their Baby Jesus figure from the crib in their homes to St. Peter's Square in Rome where the Holy Father blesses both the people and the figurines during the Angelus. This has become affectionately known as 'Bambinelli Sunday'.

Families are invited to bring their figure of the Baby Jesus to any of the Masses next weekend 11th/12th December to be blessed OR to have their figure to hand if joining the Mass from home via webcam.

A suggestion is, following the blessing, place your 'Bambinelli' in a gift box, wrap it and save it for Christmas. Let this be the first gift your family opens on Christmas morning and together place the Baby Jesus into the family crib. Say a prayer of blessing together asking God to protect your family and thanking God for the gift of His Son.
