Catholic Schools Week gives us an opportunity to celebrate the gifts that our schools bring to parish life and to acknowledge the contribution they make to the local community. The vision for Catholic schools in particular, upholds the values of the Gospel, and their ethos is open, inclusive, and respectful of all. Our schools aspire to operate within a faith-based ethos which reflects a vision and philosophy that is caring and nurturing as well as academic.

This coming week the schools will mark Catholic Schools Week as a school community, and because of current restrictions they will not be involving others to

the extent that they would have previously. Wednesday of Catholic Schools Week has traditionally been a day when the intergenerational Church was celebrated, and grandparents would have been very involved.
