A Listening Lent

Pope Francis has called for a Universal Synod of the Church. By its nature, it will be four-fold: Parish, Diocesan, National and Universal. 'Synod' is an ancient word whose meaning draws upon the deepest themes of revelation. It indicates the path along which the people of God walk together. It is a process that seeks to give voice to all the faithful and to listen attentively.

Pope Francis wants to hear from the whole Church about the reality of being part of the Church right now. He wants

us to listen to what God is saying to us through the experiences of one another. He wants us to listen with openness and to speak with courage.

The responses that emerge from the 'Listening Lent' process will form and inform our submission as a diocese to the Synod. They should also provide valuable learnings for us as three parishes and as a diocese.

The central question for the Church is: How is our 'journeying together' as a Church happening today in our parish? And where is God calling us to grow in this journey together? These questions will be explored under three themes: Communion - Participation - Mission.

Next weekend we begin our 'Listening Lent', and it will continue over the Sundays of Lent. Culminating in a parish meeting for Naas, Sallins and Two Mile House on Thursday 24th March in Killashee House Hotel.


Bishop Denis has asked us to consult widely, firstly with all who attend Sunday Mass and with those who attend church occasionally. He also urges us to go beyond the walls of our churches and into the wider community. The Parish/Diocesan Synodal process will include listening to prisoners, to the travelling community, students in our schools and colleges, people who live with disability, those belonging to the LGBTQ+ community.

Pope Francis invites us as the people of God to 'allow hope to flourish, to inspire trust, bind up wounds, weave together relationships, awaken a dawn of hope, to learn from one another, to enlighten minds and warm hearts'.

It is with an open and generous heart that we entrust this work to the Lord. May the Lord guide us on this journey we undertake together!

at 7.30pm at St Corban's Cemetery.
