

The Children's Rosary Group is a united prayer movement



that was formed in 2011 in the US, and has spread throughout the world to 35 different countries. By God's grace, a new group was formed in Cork in October 2021. There are now 12 groups in Ireland praying in parishes and schools. After learning about the growing interest in Ireland, **a new group was formed in Sallins** in November by local volunteers and the Legion of Mary.

The rosary group gives children an opportunity to develop deep roots in faith, learn about the life of Jesus and to help them in their spiritual journey.

All children can participate, the older children take turns on reading the meditation and reciting the decades, while the younger children lay flowers at the feet of Our Lady.

If you would like your child to learn the rosary and experience the benefits of praying as a group, please feel free to come along, as a family, to Sallins Church every Saturday at 6pm.
