### **Listening Lent - Your Voice Matters**

As we outlined in the newsletter last weekend, Pope Francis has called for a Universal Synod of the Church. He wants to hear from the whole Church about the reality of being part of the Church right now. The first level of this four-fold process is Parish. He wants us, in the parish, to think about the following questions;

#### Communion

1. Thinking about the Church and our parish,

how and when do I find being part of it a source of joy or nourishment for me in my faith? when might it bring disappointment or pain?

#### **Participation**

2. When I hear the word 'Church',

who do I think of?
who is missing?
whom do we need to listen to?
how can we be more inclusive?

#### **Mission**

3. Thinking about how we as a parish community bring the love of Christ into the world,

what one thing does our local parish do really well?
what one thing could it do better?

what one thing could I do?

what specific hope or dream do I have for the Church moving forward?

We invite you to take home a questionnaire, to fill it in over the course of the next days or weeks and to return it to the *synod box* in one of the four Churches or in either Parish Office by Sunday 27th March.

We invite everyone (it doesn't matter whether you have filled in the questionnaire or not) to come to a Parish gathering to discuss these questions on Thursday 24th March in the Killashee House

Hotel from 7.30pm until 9.30pm. For planning reasons, if you would like to attend, please let us know by emailing office@naasparish.net by Sunday 20th March. Refreshments will be served afterwards.
