Confirmation Retreats 2022 - In the footsteps of St. Brigid.



During the months of May and June, the Confirmation Retreats are taking place for the young people who were confirmed in March this year, and are based on a walk in the footsteps of St Brigid.

Each group travels to Kildare Town and they begin with a visit to St Brigid's Cathedral, where the Verger, Mr John Moore, meets them and outlines some of the shared history of our Christian Communities.

This is followed by a visit to the Round Tower, and to the Fire Temple, where they hear the beginnings of the Brigidine story.





Afterwards, weather permitting, they travel to St Brigid's Well, where they reflect on the Gifts of the Holy Spirit,

and how so many of the Symbols of the Spirit are to be found in nature.

Finally, they visit the Parish Church to see the icon of St.

Brigid. Each group spends time walking, chatting,
listening and praying, and thinking about faith, family
and friendship.

They also attend Mass as a group on the day.
