IRISH MARTYRS MEMORIAL DAY

Monday, June 20, is the Memorial Day for the 17 Irish Martyrs who were beatified in Rome by Pope John Paul II on 27 September 1992.

The 17 were martyred between 1579 and 1654 and include 1 woman, 5 laymen, 1 religious brother, 6 priests, 3 bishops and 1 archbishop.
