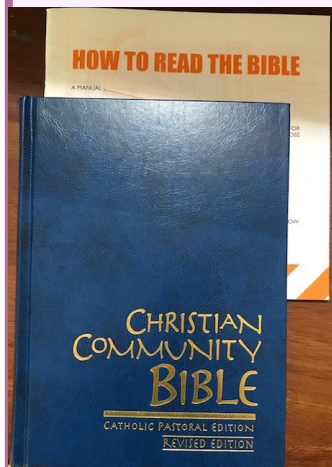
## Pope Francis' Prayer for Small Businesses
