I am sometimes asked if I miss being on the missions. In Africa I spent 24 years in Liberia and 13 years in South Africa. They are two different countries with different settings. I went to Liberia in 1971 and that was my main experience of living and working in Africa. Living

conditions were quite basic. Electricity - sometimes; water - sometimes; phone and post were irregular. Climate - hot, humid and a lot of rain. Mosquitoes nightly and in abundance. Catholics were a small minority - less than 5%. There was a language difficulty but we got by with English. Money was scarce. We depended on home support and outside help though the local community who did their best and even contributed to the Mission Sunday collection. Working with the people was great but slow. 'Parliamentary' procedure for meetings was excellent. Church ministry involved the normal church services and devotions. The community excelled in singing, participation, movement/rhythm and there was plenty of time. We always had an adult catechumens program. Alongside, was work at schools, clinics and small development projects. There were no local state supports.

Do I miss it? Yes of course. But time has moved on and a lot has happened since.

I joined the SMA (Society of African Missions) and our founder had a number of aims as a Mission policy:

- 1. To advance the work of God.
- 2. To work in Africa and with people of African origin.
- 3. To help form the local clergy.
- 4. To develop my own spirituality as a missionary.

These are more refined today to include: working for justice, enculturation and the environment.

Third world countries are at the mercy of so many forces as a result of poverty which is highlighted with famines, droughts, conflict and exploitation.

Pope Francis has given the theme for this Mission Sunday as "You shall be my Witnesses" (Acts 1:8) and "To the ends of the earth". This challenges us all to go beyond our geographical boundaries and comfort zones into situations and places where missionary witness of Christ has not yet arrived, bringing the Good News of His love. The Church must keep looking outward and testify to all people, whatever their circumstances, the love of Christ. Missionaries need our prayers and financial support. This Sunday we have the opportunity to help.

I thank you for the great support down the years and pray with God's blessings and our support the work of mission will continue in Jesus' name. Fr. Michael
