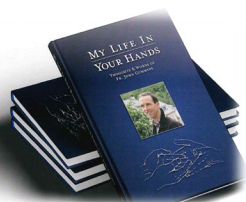

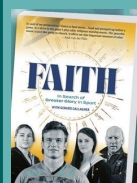

Association of Catholics Ireland, Zoom Meeting
“Pitfalls in the Terminology of Sacrifice”

with Dr Tom O'Loughlin, professor of historical theology

According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, the sacrament of the Mass - the Eucharist - is called 'the Holy Sacrifice because it makes present the one sacrifice of Christ the Saviour and includes the Church's offering'.

Archbishop Eamon Martin asked us to think of making 'personal sacrifices in answer to the cry of the Earth'.

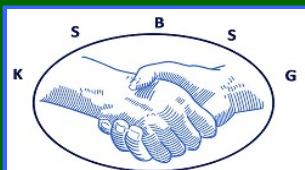
And yet Christian ideas of sacrifice have been blamed by some historians for much of the violence of history, including the Crusades and the bloodletting of WWI.

So how are we to understand Christian sacrifice today, faced with 21st century challenges?

In examining aspects of the history of the idea of sacrifice, Dr Tom O'Loughlin, , will deal with "some of the pitfalls in the way we use the terminology of sacrifice".
