The Winter Season - reception of Holy Communion

As we move into the winter season, everybody is conscious of the possibility of a new surge of Covid 19, along with the flu and other respiratory viruses which are circulating (within the community). Bearing in mind all that we have learned over the past two years about the transmission of disease and the responsibility we all have to care for those who might be vulnerable, we are encouraging parishioners to consider **using face masks** while attending Mass. We are in an enclosed and potentially crowded space. We ask people to continue with hand hygiene practice by **using the hand sanitiser** provided. It would be our preference that people receive **Holy Communion on the hand** and in the interests of the wellbeing of our Eucharistic Ministers, they have been instructed not to give Holy Communion on the tongue.
