


## Bambínellí Sunday

The Blessing of the Bambinelli (Baby Jesus) is a tradition which began in Rome. Each year on the Third Sunday of Advent (Gaudete Sunday), the Pope Francis invites children to bring the Baby Jesus figure from their family Nativity scene to Mass for a blessing.

At the children's Masses in our parishes this weekend, we have a Baby Jesus figure for the children to bring home with them. Families are also invited to bring the Baby Jesus from their own crib at home to any Mass to have it blessed.

## Naas and Sallins Boxes of Envelopes for 2023

These boxes are now available to collect from the Church porches.

If we could ask you to write your name and address on the first few envelopes which you use, this would allow us to keep a track of your donations during the year. If you donate more than €250 in any one year the parish can claim back the tax which you have already paid when earning that amount in the first place.

In recent years the parishes have claimed back over €70,000 from revenue under this scheme.

If you think that you might not have written your name and address on the envelope for the current year, it is not too late! you can still write your name and address on your envelope for the remaining weeks of 2022. If you have any questions or for further information on participating in the tax back scheme, please call into the Parish Office on the Sallins Road.

**Traditionally, <u>Sallins Parishioners</u>** have kept the same envelope number each year. However, in recent years there have been a good number of boxes of envelopes which remain unused. So, in order to reduce our impact on the environment and the cost of envelopes, we have ordered fewer boxes this year. We ask you therefore to pick any box of envelopes you like and to write your name and address on the first few envelopes which you use of your new box.

Please note that **Midnight Mass** will take place at **11pm** this year in the Church of Our Lady and St. David. Please see the back page for the full Christmas Mass Schedule.




