think about ..

John the Baptist came to bear witness to Jesus. Who have been the people who have borne witness to us of the good news of the gospel that God loves us - a friend, a parent, a teacher, etc? To whom have we borne that witness?

John appears in the story as one who had the courage to be himself in the face of opposition. He was also a person who knew his own value, did not make exaggerated claims and was content with his mission. Can you recall times when you have been

content to be yourself, without pretending to be more than you are? What was it like to have that freedom, even in the face of criticism from others?

John was 'the voice of one crying out in the wilderness' - announcing confidently to those in the wilderness that they must not despair because God's grace may come to them at any moment. Have you had the experience of being in the wilderness, feeling lost? From whom did you hear a voice that gave you hope? Have you been able to give hope to other people when they were in the wilderness?

As we celebrate the Feast of the Immaculate Conception on Thursday, we carry with us in prayer the intention of Pro-Life and a concern for appreciating the value of life in all its stages.

The Temporary Closure of the Entrance Hall in Ballycane (The Lobby!)

Parishioners attending Sunday Mass last weekend in Ballycane, learned about the unexpected closure of the Church Lobby. A decision taken for safety reasons. Unfortunately, the tiles are lifting with ledges forming making it unsafe and creating 'trip hazards' as the photographs below hopefully capture.



We are actively working on resolving the issue which will necessitate the entire re-tiling of the lobby.

Progress depends on the availability of the tiles (110m²), the turnaround involved and then the subsequent job of fitting the tiles.

Message from Bishop Denis regarding safeguarding

Review by the National Board for Safeguarding Children in the Catholic Church in Ireland

I am pleased to announce that the National Board for the Safeguarding of Children in the Catholic Church in Ireland (the National Board) will be commencing their review of safeguarding practice in the Diocese of Kildare and Leighlin on December 12th.

The National Board was established in 2006 to provide advice, services and assistance in furtherance of the development of the safeguarding of children within the Roman Catholic Church on the island of Ireland; and to monitor compliance with legislation, policy and best practice and to report on these activities.

The Diocese entered into an agreement with the National Board through signing a Memorandum of Understanding and committed to the Safeguarding Children – Policy and Standards for the Catholic Church in Ireland 2016 issued by the National Board.

To assess our compliance, I invited the National Board to undertake a review of practice this year. The Diocese was previously reviewed in 2012 under the Safeguarding Children – Policy and Standards for the Catholic Church in Ireland 2008.

The purpose of this second review is to assess the safeguarding practice in the Diocese of Kildare and Leighlin against the Catholic Church in Ireland's current standards as detailed in Safeguarding Children – Policy and Standards for the Catholic Church in Ireland 2016.

In advance of this, I encourage anyone who has a child safeguarding concern or who wishes to report an allegation of child abuse to contact a Diocesan Designated Liaison Person or An Garda Siochana or TUSLA or contact the National Board.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all those who encourage and facilitate children's involvement in parish activities and all those who contribute to safeguarding in their local parishes.
