Begin with a prayer to prepare your heart, and take a few moments to adjust from the noise of the outside world to the silence and peace of Christ's presence.






Pre-Lenten Novena:

We pray for world leaders, for compassion, strength and wisdom to guide their choices.


We pray for the world, that in this moment of crisis, we may reach out in solidarity, to our brothers and sisters in need.


