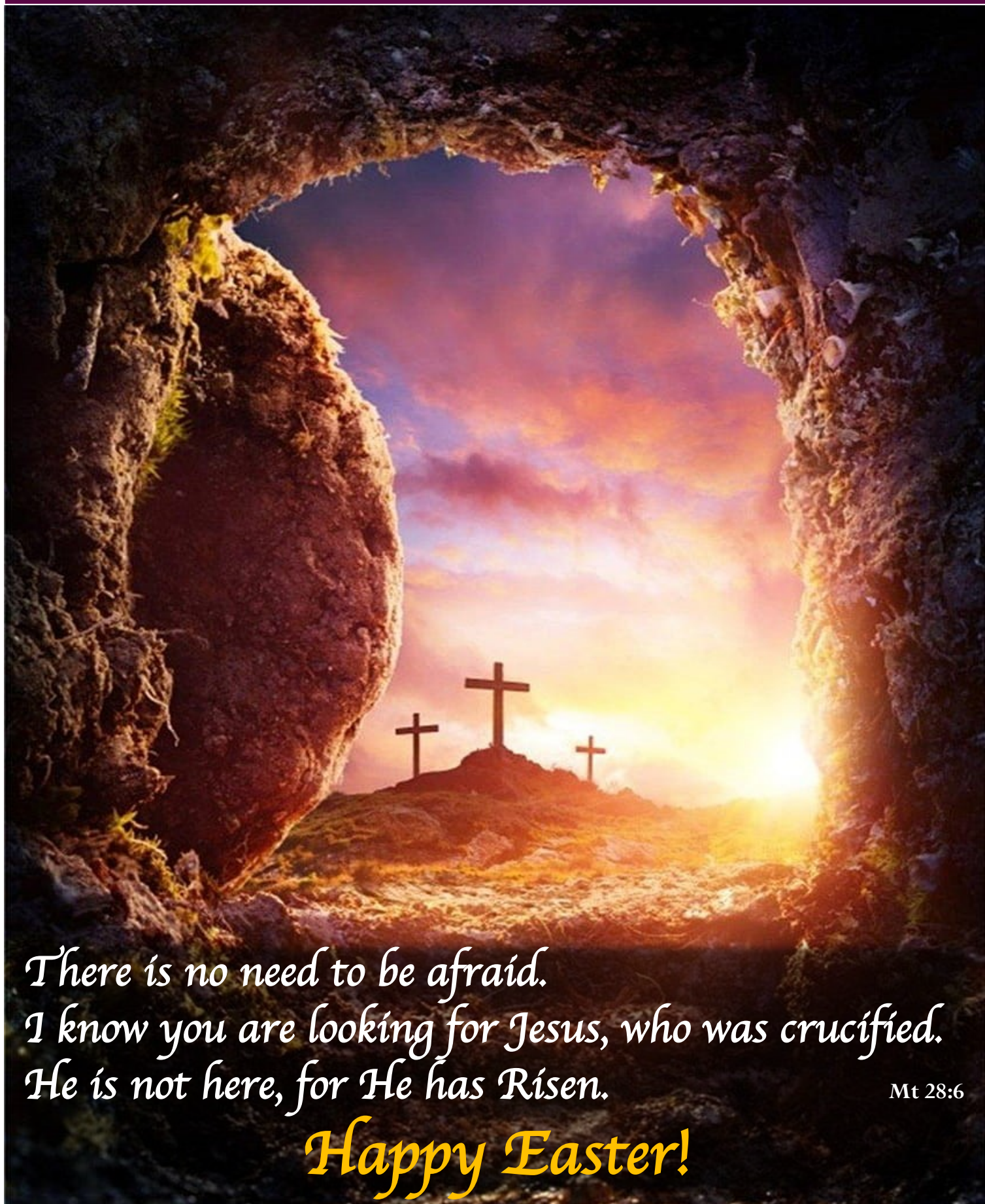

- **2.50pm Benediction**
- **3.00pm Holy Mass**

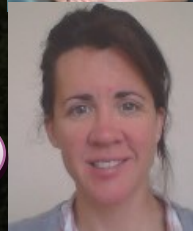
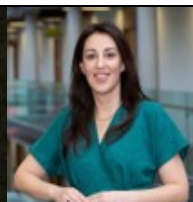
