joy is ever in...


And let others summer in my shade, Lord, and share whatever summer's peace is mine to give, whatever summer's light is mine to shed, whatever summer's warmth is mine to share...

Good God of every season and every day this week, come summer with me, Lord, and let the child in my heart spend this summer in your love...





Tip of the week: Protect existing sources of food and shelter for pollinators If the following already occur in your garden, they should be protected: patches of wildflowers or "weedy" plants (food); flowering hedgerows (food); bare soil on flat or sloped ground, e.g. lawn edging (shelter); long grass (shelter); dry stone walls (shelter). www.pollinators.ie
