The National Ploughing Championships were held in Ratheniska, Co Laois last week. Our own Diocese of Kildare & Leighlin was well represented on the Diocesan stand, providing a lovely welcome for visitors each of day. Bishop Denis, was joined, among others, by priests and parish representatives. Our own parishes were well represented with young people from Two Mile House, Naas and Sallins there on both the Wednesday and Thursday.

The stand had a quiet prayer space for those who wanted to spend some time in prayer, and offered shared prayer a number of times each day. There was a prayer wall, where visitors placed petitions, and these were remembered during the day. Over the three days, we also created a St Brigid's cloak, with pieces added by visitors to the stand. Most of all, there was an opportunity for people to sit for a while, to rest the feet and enjoy a cuppa and a biscuit, and to chat to those representatives of the Diocese who were present each day.

This year, the outstanding feature of the ploughing championship was definitely the mud! Heavy rain in the run up to the championships and on the first day made its mark, particularly on the routes from the carparks into the village itself. Despite the improvement in weather these fields remained waterlogged and muddy. Quite a challenge, even for those who had the ultimate fashion accessory – a good pair of wellies.

Sincere thanks to all of our young people, and to the members of the youth ministry team who accompanied them, for representing us so well, and for providing a warm and friendly faith presence at this fascinating event.


