You will be pleased to know that the App is as popular as ever.

Thank you very much to everyone who responded to our recent request for feedback. You seem to very much appreciate the ability to access the three webcams and to keep up-to-date on the Funeral Announcements in the Parish. This is backed up by the statistics on the App itself which show that during the month of September:

people viewed one of the webcams via the app.

people viewed one of the September newsletters on the app.

Also, since the dates for 2024 were added to the app there has been a noticeable increase in the number of people visiting the Sacraments section of the app. The dates can be accessed by clicking on Sacraments and then selecting First Holy Communion or Confirmation. This section will be updated with more information over the course of the year.

'Mass Times' is now updated to include the new Mass Schedule for Naas, Sallins and Two Mile House as well as the Mass times in the Churches in Kill and Ardclough Parish.

Keep up-to-date with parish life in an environmentally friendly way by viewing the weekly **Parish Newsletter** on the Parish App. The newsletter is available on the App from friday evenings, previous issues also available.

The **Parish Lotto** tab allows you to play the parish lotto online. You may purchase up to four lines of numbers for one, five or ten weeks or for the whole year.

The **Results** are then posted on the app on a Thursday morning so that you can check out how you did.

MY LIFE IN YOUR HANDS by Fr. John Cummins


The first book of 'My Life in Your Hands' contained the sermons for Sundays in Year A of the 3-year liturgical calendar.

This second volume contains Fr. John's sermons for Year B and Year C of the church cycle. It also contains reflections for secondary school students, tributes by friends and numerous photographs.

Fr. John spent most of his priestly ministry in Carlow town where he was chaplain in the then Regional College and Administrator in the Cathedral. A native of Newbridge, he earlier served in Naas. He became PP of Abbeyleix and Ballyroan only 18 months before his death.

The homilies of Fr. John are rooted not only in scripture, but also in the everyday issues of contemporary Ireland. They will be useful for personal reflection at any time and will be valued by anyone with an interest in religion and spirituality. "My Life in Your Hands" retails at €15 and all proceeds after printing costs will be donated to the diocese of Kildare and Leighlin.
