The Tragedy of War

The ongoing situation in the Holy Land is deeply distressing: the pain and anguish inflicted upon the people of Israel on that first Saturday in October was random, extreme and targeted the lives of innocent men, women and children. The Irish citizen, Tom Hand, expressed the unthinkable....that he was relieved his 8 year old daughter Emily was dead rather than being captured, frightened and alone. That attack by Hamas has given way to the pitiful and horrendous plight of the people of Gaza.

This is an ongoing conflict with a long history, and in any war situation no one people has a monopoly on suffering, and certainly two wrongs don't make a right.

The people of Gaza, so many of them children, one million in fact, are now corralled into a geographical area half the size of County Louth. They have nowhere to go or to escape to, deprived of food, water and shelter. Childhood traumas are being created, it's even hard to view on our screens. Their existence already, over many years has been stifling, indeed suffocating.

We can only hope and pray that the international chorus appealing for a ceasefire will be heeded. Similarly, it is our hope that the humanitarian efforts that seek to reach the people of Gaza will materialise in terms of volume and speed. Not to, is an inhumane denial.

All this tragedy is so contrary to the gospel invitation: 'to love God and to love our neighbour'. When we see age old tensions, fractured relationships, deep suspicion and hatred, we see how poorly, we, the people of the world, have succeeded in loving our neighbour over the centuries. Perhaps it is a reflection on how poorly we have loved God.

There was one chink of light or humanity this week! The exchange between an 85 year old Israeli woman and her captors. As she was being released, she took the hand of her captor and saying goodbye, wished him 'shalom' or peace in Hebrew.

Pope Francis has described this latest chapter as a human catastrophe: urging all peoples to take one side only, the side of peace.

This Weekend is available to all married couples at no fixed charge beyond the deposit of €50 per couple and a voluntary donation.




