Handing on the Faith



At baptism we become part of the Christian family. The symbol of the candle, lit from the Paschal Candle is a powerful acknowledgement that we have invited the Light of Christ into our lives. The sacrament of Confirmation acknowledges that the child must now begin to accept this responsibility for themselves.

Parent: I give you this candle as a sign of your Faith. We lit this candle for you when you were a small child, and we helped you to keep it burning within our family circle. Now that you are older, we pass the light of Faith to you to hold for yourself.

Keep it. Treasure it. Share it. You are the Light of the World.

Child: I thank you for the gift of Faith which you have passed on to me. As I take it from you, I am taking the first steps on my own journey of Faith. With your help, I will keep it, treasure it and share it. We are the Light of the World.
