### TRANSFIGURATION OF THE LORD

With the second Sunday of Lent we meditate upon the transfiguration of the Lord. Traditionally, the story of Jesus ascending the mountain and revealing his divinity to his closest disciples was often used to test the awareness of novice meditators who were asked by their masters the old question: 'On the mountain who changed?'

While after a cursory glance at the story many would reply incorrectly that 'Jesus changed on the mountain', those who had



gone a little deeper in their reflection would see that it was the disciples who changed as they saw Jesus as he truly is, not just on the mountain, but always.

This deeper reflection of scripture allows us to recognise that as we progress in our contemplation we begin to see reality as it actually is, transfigured always by Divine Love and as a gateway always to Divine presence. (from 'Still Points', Br. Richard Hendrick)





This initiative is being coordinated by the Youth Groups and will continue for the whole of Lent.




