Mass of Healing Anointing of the Sick

Next Wednesday Evening at the Church of the Irish Martyrs in Ballycane we will celebrate a Mass of Healing during which the Sacrament of the Sick or the Anointing of the Sick will take place. This opportunity to pray and to seek God's healing coincides with the World Day of the Sick which is marked each year on the Feast Day of Our Lady of Lourdes.

On this day the Church bears witness as always, with special concern to the tender mercy, and love of God So, perhaps you can join us on Wednesday Evening, towards all who suffer. Those who experience illness, mental anguish or pain. We are especially mindful of children and their parents who love them and care for them.

According to St. James....By the Sacred anointing of the sick and the prayer of the priests, the whole church commends those who are sick to the suffering and glorified Lord, that he may heal and save them.

Illness when experienced reminds us of our powerlessness and the human limitation of life. We are utterly dependent upon God, and upon the expertise of those trained medically to look after us when our need is greatest. Often illness provokes in us a deeper search for God and a return to Him, to the heart of Jesus, Mary and Joseph.

"Through this holy anointing may the Lord in his love and mercy help you with the grace of the Holy Spirit."

"May the Lord who frees you from sin save you and raise you up."



Féile Bríde (Brigid's Festival) is a week-long series of events commencing on the eve of St.Brigid's Day.




