Sallins Church Centenary - Refurbishment Works


In October 2024 the Church of Our Lady and the Guardian Angels in Sallins will be 100 years old. In order to mark this special occasion it is planned to carry out some improvement works to the church. Bishop Denis has also kindly agreed to dedicate our newly refurbished Church at a date to be confirmed. The improvement works are designed to enhance this unique church that has been loved and cared for by generations of parishioners. The plans have been formed with advice from church restoration experts and discussed and reviewed by the Parish Finance Committee and the Parish Pastoral Council. The main focus will be improvements to the church sanctuary, and it is also planned to enhance the body of the church with improved lighting and a new carpet. The sanctuary is going to be somewhat enlarged and will have a new single-level carpeted floor. The sanctuary walls are going to be painted to lift and brighten it and to emphasise the window. The sanctuary doors will be replaced with new decorative doors.

New sanctuary furniture and a new altar will be provided. The existing altar is going to be refurbished and re-positioned in its original High Altar format under the stained glass window. In order to allow this to take place, a temporary altar will be provided in the coming weeks.

In the main body of the church, the Stations of the Cross will be re-positioned and re-hung. You may notice that the confession box has been removed. It wasn't in use due to its poor acoustics and restricted exit. It was also in very poor condition. It didn't make sense to invest money in upgrading it when its design would continue to render it unusable.

Over the coming weeks you may see evidence of the ongoing programme of works with tradespeople in the church during the weekdays. Mass will continue to be celebrated as per the normal schedule. The aim is to carry out the work with the minimum of disruption but inevitably there will be some, for which we apologise in advance. You will be kept informed as the programme progresses. Your understanding is greatly appreciated.

It may be necessary to close the church completely for a few days later in the year to finalise the work. If so, it will be well-planned and take
